

## **Alpharetta Senate Meeting Minutes**

**Friday, October 14th, 2016**

**Building AB, Room 106**

The regular meeting of the Alpharetta Senate of Georgia State University was held on Friday, October 14<sup>th</sup>, 2016, at 12:05 am in building AB, room 106. The minutes from the meeting of Friday, September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2016, were read and approved.

A report was given by Executive Vice President Chelsea Green. She stated that the executive meetings every Wednesday from 3:00 to 5:00pm are going well. Also, she explained that because PAC doesn't have an advisor at the moment, it's important to get students to join by helping with recruitment. Furthermore, she suggested making the application for SGA solely online to make the application process easier. Additionally, regarding the clothing drive for the Salvation Army SGA is hosting in November, there are buckets upstairs we can use that already have directions for donating on them. She suggested putting the buckets outside the tutoring center and the main student areas. Also, Chelsea reported that we need to familiarize ourselves with how to work the snow cone machine for events. Additionally, she announced that the popcorn machine is very simple to use and great for events.

The Speaker of the Senate Darrel Murray gave his report regarding the food surveys. He announced that 6 most requested places for student discounts were Moe's, Vito's Pizza, Mr. Taco, McDonalds, and Jamba Juice.

The Communications Director Julianne Sittler also gave a report. She announced that the 5 most requested places for her surveys were Moe's, Subway, Jamba Juice, McDonalds, and Pepperonis Tavern. Also she made the following announcements: coffee makers are not allowed in the SGA office, side walk chalk can be used for advertising for events, and there is a large instant coffee and tea maker upstairs that can be used during the distress events for finals.

The Finance Director Nick Harford gave his report. He announced that the top requested places for his surveys were Subway, Moe's, McDonalds, Cuzi's Fresh Café, Caribbean Fiesta, and Jerusalem Bakery. Also, for the financial advice event he is planning, he decided it would be beneficial to talk to faculty first, get their feedback, and then talk to the students. Furthermore, he gave his financial report stating that SGA's funds are the same as the previous week, with \$60 spent and \$4990 left in the SGA budget.

For new business, Election Day is November 8<sup>th</sup> and SGA will host an event with clips of the debate and popcorn.

The meeting adjourned at 12:37 pm and the next meeting will be on October the 28th 2016.
