

**Dunwoody Campus Senate Minutes**  
**Friday, December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2016**

The regular meeting of the Dunwoody Senate of Georgia State University was held on Friday, December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2016, at 10:41 A.M., in Room NB 2100 of the Dunwoody Campus Student Center, the Speaker of the Senate being in the chair. Quorum was not determined due to the absence of (3) senators out of five (5) presently sitting senators.

Reports were given by Speaker Lesly Veve, EVP Chari Guzman, Communications Director Olivia Abie, Senator Jesse Calixte on behalf of the Clubs and Organizations Committee, Senator Fariha Alam on behalf of Student services.

Speaker Lesly Veve informed that he won't be part of the executive board next semester since he's transferring to the downtown campus. Senators Fariha Alam, and Senator Kwaku Bonsie also won't be part of SGA next semester. Speaker Lesly Veve also informed that the senators that are leaving need to find a student to replace them for the spring semester.

Executive Vice President informed that there won't be a spring retreat due to a lack of funds, instead the retreat will be held at one of the perimeter campuses. Chari Guzman also informed that PAC needs more money for the spring fling. Chari Guzman presented a spring 2017 programming outline.

Communications Director Olivia Abie informed about the initiative of a faculty staff to start a charity donation for the families that have been affected by the wildfires in the state of Tennessee.

Ms. Aprille Williams informed about recruiting more students for SGA, and stressed how important it is to have a plan of action for the students that will be here next semester. Ms. Aprille Williams informed that the Election committee will be held on February 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> for Dunwoody hearing and deliveries, and February 17<sup>th</sup> for Alpharetta. Ms. Aprille Williams informed about MLK service, and that she's looking for a company for students to volunteer. She also informed that she's discussing town meetings, and on January 26<sup>th</sup> meeting 100 days of election. Ms. Aprille informed that SAF proposal applications will be available December 1st, and College Wide hearing will be held on the 24<sup>th</sup> of February. Ms. Aprille Williams informed that we need to identify students to sit on the committees next semester. She also informed that she's still working on contracts, which will have to be put in place before January 21<sup>st</sup>.

In Open Forum, Speaker of the Senate Lesly Veve invited each senator to discuss their experience being part of the SGA. Speaker Lesly Veve gave each senator a set of questions to answer, in order to adjust and improve SGA next semester.

The meeting adjourned at 12:20 P.M.
