

## **Alpharetta Senate Meeting Minutes**

**Friday, September 30th, 2016**

**Building AB, Room 106**

The regular meeting of the Alpharetta Senate of Georgia State University was held on Friday, September 30th, 2016, at 12:10 am in building AB, room 106. The minutes from the meeting of September 16th were read and approved.

A report was given by Executive Vice President Chelsea Green. She stated that Voter Registration went well and had a great turnout. She proposes that for future events where PAC and SGA are combined, schedules for volunteers should be coordinated better.

The finance director Nick Harford gave his report stating that SGA spent \$1500 on travel and \$60 for name badges. The remaining SGA funds are \$4990. Also, he proposed to run an event where students and teachers can get financial coaching for free. The event program will teach people how to make and save their own money. Additionally, the finance director suggested to set up an information table at the front doors.

SGA advisor Aprille Williams gave the PAC report stating that there were 90 sign-ins at the voter registration event. Additionally, she announced that Ms. Bass' last day was October the 30<sup>th</sup>. She also gave the SGA report announcing that today, October 30<sup>th</sup> was the deadline for clubs to submit their charter forms. Furthermore, she stated that some SGA office hours need to be revised due to confusion in scheduling. The SGA nametag badges and the homecoming t-shirts also came in this week. Additionally, members need to continue recruiting and should think of doing more orientation classes. She also discussed how maybe we should put the recruitment table in a different location to change things up. Also, SGA members need to make the SGA calendar of events for this school year and have the first draft completed by October 21<sup>st</sup>. She suggested possible events such as celebrating Veterans Day, Native American heritage month, viewing party for Election Day, Letters to the Troops, and Adopt an Angle.

For announcements, the next upcoming event is the pre homecoming bash on October the 13<sup>th</sup> in room 1130 from 11:00 am – 3:00 pm. The event will have refreshments and a photo booth. Additionally, on October 18<sup>th</sup>, there will be an event with food and a mechanical bull in the west parking lot. Lots of volunteers will be needed. In new business, Nia Powell wanted to start a community service and youth mentorship club.

The meeting adjourned at 1:03 pm and the next meeting will be on October the 14<sup>th</sup> 2016.
